- Focus on proactive strategies to support the wellbeing of the whole school community.

Our initiatives include

- Continue to embed whole school learning priorities – writing, feedback and retrieval and engagement.
- Continue to implement the Learning Intervention Programs.
- Maintain leadership structure that supports the wellbeing and learning success for all students.
- Utilise the pedagogical model Art and Science of Teaching, Positive Education and research informed practice to further develop an expert teaching team.
- Invest in early career teachers through an explicit induction program, ongoing professional development and mentoring
- Routinely review a range of data to inform teaching practice.
- Focus on decreasing student absence through targeted strategies to increase participation of disengaged students
- Establish opportunities for intentional collaboration to improve curriculum programs, consistency of practice, pathways and line-of-sight across year 7 – year 12
