

ADF Long Tan Youth Leadership and Teamwork Nomination Form

The ADF Long Tan Youth Leadership and Teamwork Awards recognise students who demonstrate leadership and teamwork within both the school and the broader community and who display strong values, such as doing one's best, respect for others and "mateship", that are integral to Australian society. Participation in this award program is open to students enrolled in Year 10 and/or Year 12. A student may self-nominate, or can be nominated by a member of the school community. Self-nominations must be supported/ratified by a school staff member. Please note, nominees do not need military training or experience (ie: cadets).

Process:

- 1. Check the <u>criteria</u> for the ADF Long Tan Youth Leadership and Teamwork Award. Please ensure you meet the criteria before starting the nomination process.
- 2. The nomination form is in two parts. **Complete Part A** by filling in the details below. You can do this for yourself (self-nomination) or for someone else.
- 3. Identify the school staff member you will ask to support the nomination and ask for their permission.
- 4. **Complete Part B** of the nomination in <u>Microsoft Forms</u> (this form is only available with a Department of Education email address as nominations can only be made by a student and/or staff member).
- 5. Email any supporting documentation (eg: certificates, letters) and the completed Part A form to Ms Hixon khixo1@eq.edu.au with the subject line 'ADF nomination' by **3.00pm on Wednesday 23 July 2025.**
