TAFE QLD is offering a Trade Taster Program to eligible Year 10 students to try out a trade without needing to commit to a full qualification or apprenticeship. This program will allow students to determine if a trade is the right option for them, or to test out a potential career path for the future.

The TAFE Trade Taster Program delivers training to small groups of up to 14 students one day per week for approximately 7 weeks. Throughout the program, students get to try at least three different trade areas as well as having the opportunity to complete their Construction Industry White Card.

They will be able to choose from a selection of trade areas including light automotive, heavy automotive, carpentry, electrical, engineering, furniture making, plumbing, rail infrastructure and wet trades (bricklaying & tiling). During the program they will complete a number of individual competencies from various TAFE Queensland courses, giving them a taste for what a trades career would be like.

To take part in the Trade Taster Program students must be in Year 10 and currently studying Maths and English at a Year 10 level. Students must also be able to arrange travel to the relevant TAFE Queensland campus where the program is offered (Acacia Ridge or Alexandra Hills).

This program is only available to Year 10 students. This program does not exhaust a student's VETiS funding entitlement but Departmental funding rules exclude students who are currently enrolled into a VETiS funded qualification. This means that if a student is currently enrolled into a VETiS funded qualification, unfortunately they are unable to enrol into the Trade Taster Program.

Approved students will need to maintain their 6-subject study-load whilst completing this course.
