This funding will be used to

- Support student attainment in NAPLAN Testing with a minimum of 95% of students achieving at or above the 2017 National minimum Standards in Reading, Writing and Numeracy
- Increase the % of students in the Upper 3 Bands in Reading, Writing and Numeracy
- Improve teacher capability in delivering quality teaching by focusing on professional development, mentoring and growth coaching
- Increase the % of students in the flexible delivery of pathways

Our initiatives include

- Continue to embed whole school literacy strategies focused on inferential comprehension, vocabulary and on paragraph writing
- Continue to implement *Polya's Problem Solving Mathematical model* and the explicit teaching of numeracy in relevant units of work across the curriculum
- Utilise the pedagogical model *Art and Science of Teaching* to further develop peer observational protocols, conferencing and feedback mechanisms
- Regularly review a range of data to inform teaching practice
- Improve in the area of Digital Technologies (Robotics and Coding)
- Improve Attendance data through 'Every Day Counts' strategy

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Employing staff to lead, manage, coach, develop lessons, implement programs (e.g. Reading at Mansfield Program (RAMP) based upon the SRA Corrective Reading Program, Literary Festival, TrackEd, U3B mathematics tutorial program), Special Education Program, data analysis, Every Day Counts, senior engagement, review programs and then report	\$373 025
Accessing external consultants such as QCAA, data specialists, other school experts (interstate) to work with staff in interpreting data, consistency in the delivery of whole school programs in particular literacy and numeracy and the student well-being development program	\$10 000
Targeted professional development for staff including <i>The Art and Science of Teaching</i>	\$150 000
Purchasing resources and teaching staff to support programs and paying a participant per capita amount (IMPACT program)	\$30 000
Purchasing resources to support Robotics and Coding into the curriculum	\$25 000
Implementation of TrackEd into Junior, Middle and Senior Secondary areas	\$15 000
