Our school initiatives are showing substantial progress toward our targets

After reviewing our 2018 *Investing for Success* agreement, it is clear that we have made progress toward our targeted student outcomes. We will continue to focus on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students, and adjust our initiatives as needed to ensure every student succeeds.

Initiatives implemented include:

- Utilised the pedagogical model *Art and Science of Teaching* Program to support teaching staff to implement whole school approaches to literacy, numeracy and research based pedagogy and to begin work in peer observational protocols, conferencing and feedback mechanisms.
- Continued with the appointment of literacy and numeracy co-ordinators to support teachers (including provision of release time and Professional Development and Learning).
- Applied targeted intervention strategies for identified students at risk of not achieving National Minimum Standards in Reading and Numeracy.
- Continued with on-going professional development for the implementation of the new QCE system in 2019.
- Continued to implement whole school literacy strategies.
- Continuation of the 'Impact' project of Critical Thinking including a Head of Program.
- Continuation of "Reading at Mansfield Program" (RAMP) based upon the SRA Corrective Reading Program. Also includes training and employment of accredited teachers and teacher aides.
- Appointment of an Associate Principals in the areas of Learning and Teaching; and Students and Performance.
- Appointment of an extra Mathematics Head of Department, English Head of Department and Science Head of Department.
