- ethical (and moral) understanding

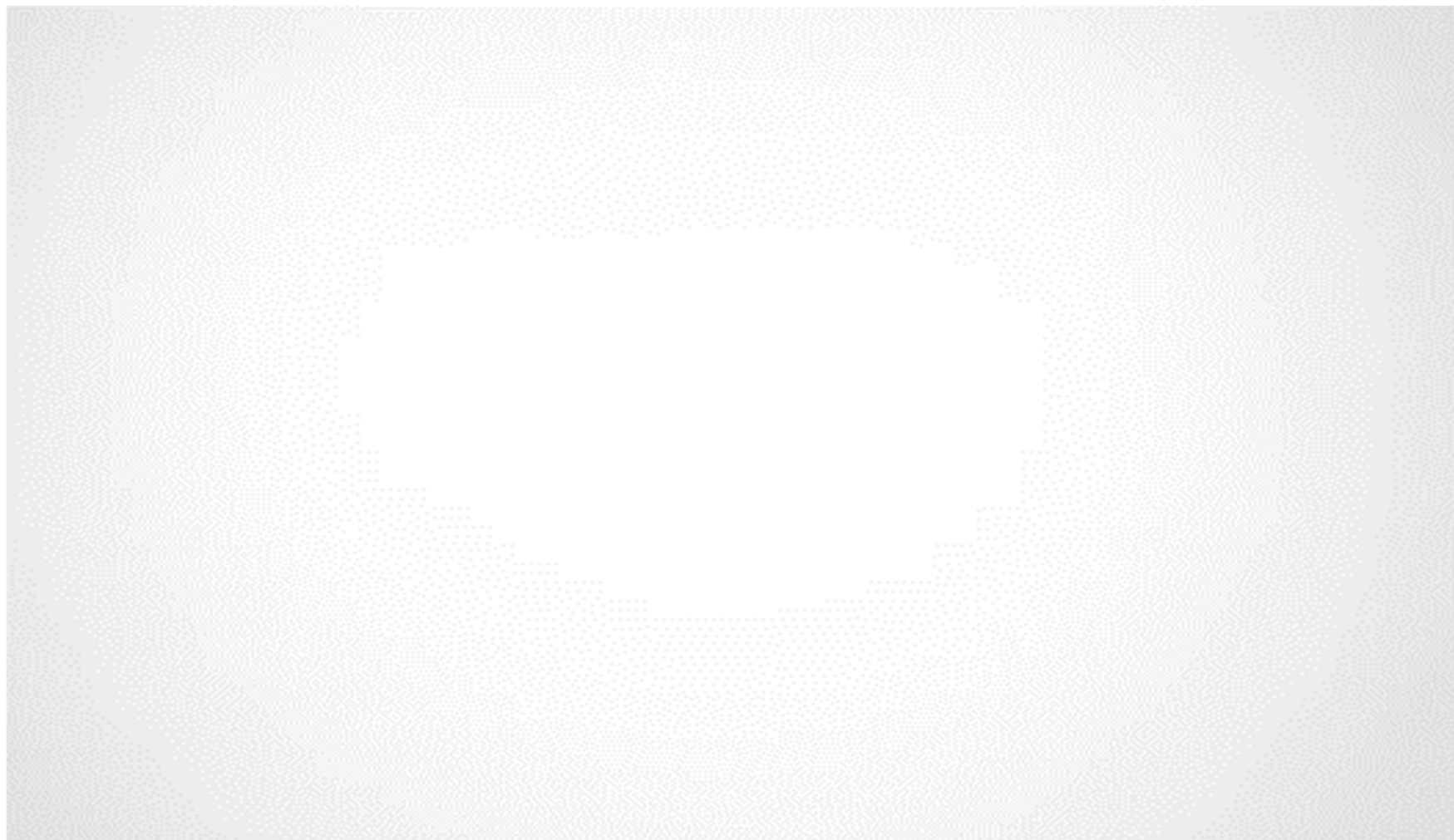
### ICT skills
