## More space

STUDENTS at Mansfield State High School will have more space with funding for two new classrooms in last week's State Budget.

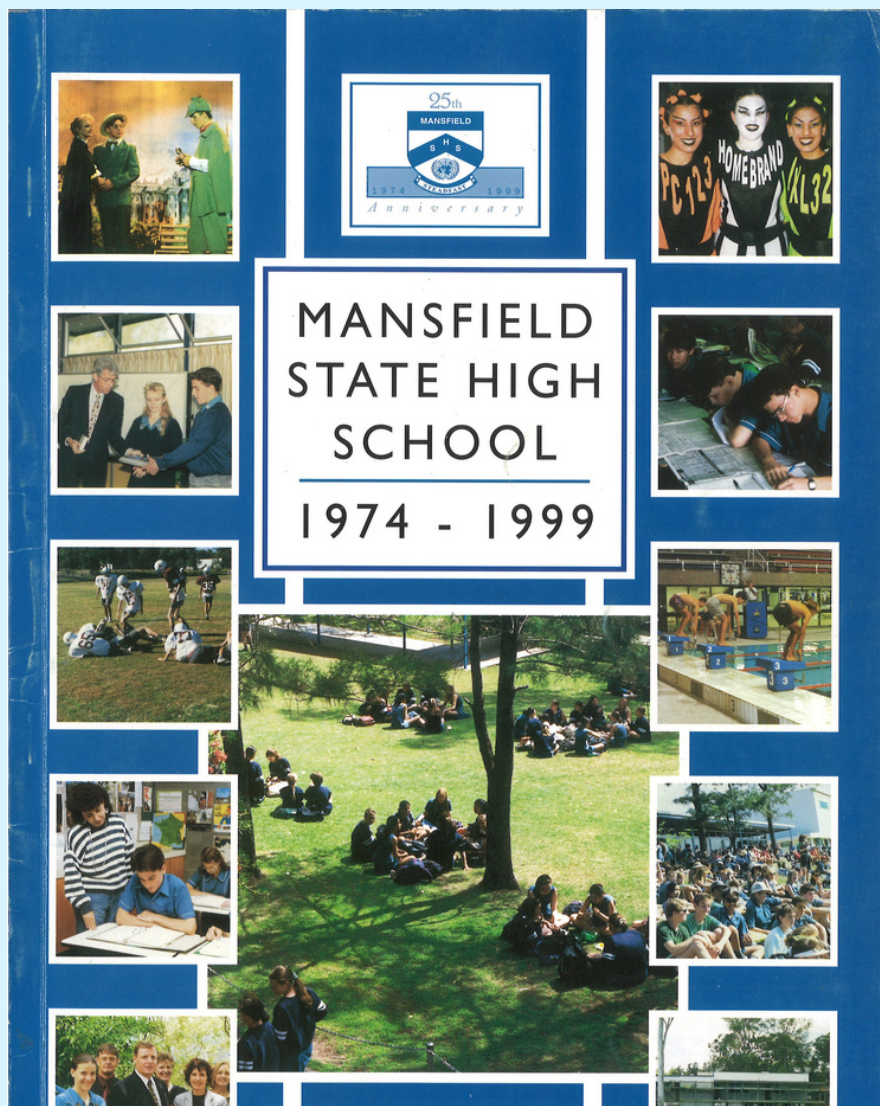
The school was allocated \$280,000 for construction of the new building.

School Parents and Citizens Association vice president David Collins said the school community was pleased with the funding allocation. Mr Collins said the school had been campaigning for additional classrooms as there was no spare space.

He said at present, the music rooms had been doubling as classrooms, so the new building would be welcomed.

In 2003 the school was running out of space and was allocated a new building in the State Government budget. The school's population was 1400 then, less than half of our current enrolment.

This year, Mansfield SHS opened the new Arts and Technology Block (P Block).
